Re-Enrollment

To ensure that all of our returning families have an opportunity to re-enroll before new family applications are accepted, the re-enrollment process will take place in the month of February. To guarantee your re-enrollment for next year, please complete your online re-enrollment and submit your \$50 re-enrollment deposit **ASAP**. Approval of new family enrollment applications will begin **February 15**.

Beginning on **February 1**, you will find a re-enrollment link on your ParentsWeb page in the family information section. Please follow the prompts, taking time to update as much information as you are able in order to ensure that our records are up-to-date. If you do not have Internet access at home, you may arrange an appointment with Nancy to complete the process in the school office.

To thank you for your diligence in completing this process in a timely way, an additional \$50 credit will be applied to your 2017-2018 tuition if your online re-enrollment and \$50 re-enrollment deposit are received by **February 28**. Families using the FACTS payment system this year and planning to use it again next year need not submit a re-enrollment deposit but will receive the \$50 tuition credit.
