## Junior High Sports

Boys Junior High Soccer and Girls Junior High Volleyball will begin practice on Monday, **August 20**. These teams will practice from 3:30-5:30pm. Junior High sports are for students in 6th–8th grades.

## Sports Admission

Season and full-year sports passes are now available. Individual, couple, and family passes are available. Admission is charged at all junior high, JV, and varsity sporting events. Admission for Zion home sporting events is \$2 per Zion student and \$5 for everyone else (non-ZCS students, adults, etc.), with a \$20 family maximum.

Admission is free for:

- ZCS students playing a current sport (i.e. volleyball player attending a soccer game this fall)

- ZCS faculty (plus one guest)
- ZCS parent working admissions or concessions for the current night (plus one guest)
- Children under 5 years of age

The season or full-year sports pass order form, along with pricing, is attached to the Weekly. This makes a great gift for grandparents! Please return the form along with your payment (payable to Mountaineer Athletic Boosters) to school.

## Sports Physicals

All students in grades 7–12 will need a sports physical dated after **April 15, 2018**, to participate in athletics at Zion during the 2018–19 school year. Sports physicals are due the first day of practice. Your child will not be allowed to participate in practices or games

until his or her physical has been given to Zion.
