

Dear parents,

Christian kids in Christian homes going to a Christian school face strong spiritual battles. We are burdened for the hearts of our kids at Zion. So we are creating space to gather together regularly in prayer.

This prayer time is for **everyone**. We envision this as an open-house style prayer time. Come when you can; leave when you must. You can stay for the whole hour or drop in for 5 minutes.

It will be a quiet space for all to lift their hearts in prayer, but where there is *no expectation or pressure* to pray aloud. At the same time, it will allow for any, who feel led, to join in community prayer with others who feel the same call.

Our first prayer time is on **Monday, September 30, from 8-9am in the Conference Room** near the Commons entrance.

If you are able to be there at the beginning of the hour, we will take the first few minutes to introduce the prayer focus for that hour and, in the future, to share how God is answering our collective prayers. For all who join later in the hour, we will have a printout of the prayer focus available for your quiet review.

We plan to alternate the day and time each week, to engage as many people as possible. Our first prayer time is on a Monday morning. The second week it will be on Tuesday afternoon from 2-3pm, alternating from that point forward. A schedule and reminders can be sent in coming weeks.

Please gather with us as we come boldly before the throne of grace, praying for the hearts at Zion.
